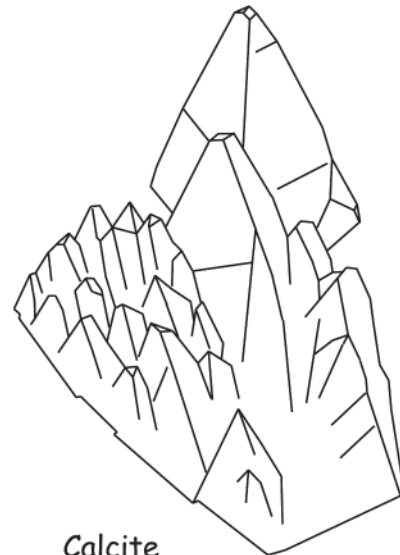
Ruby (Color: red)



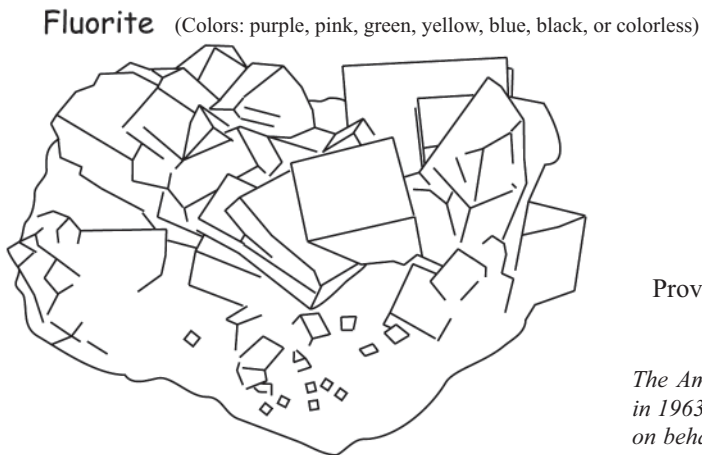
Pyrite
